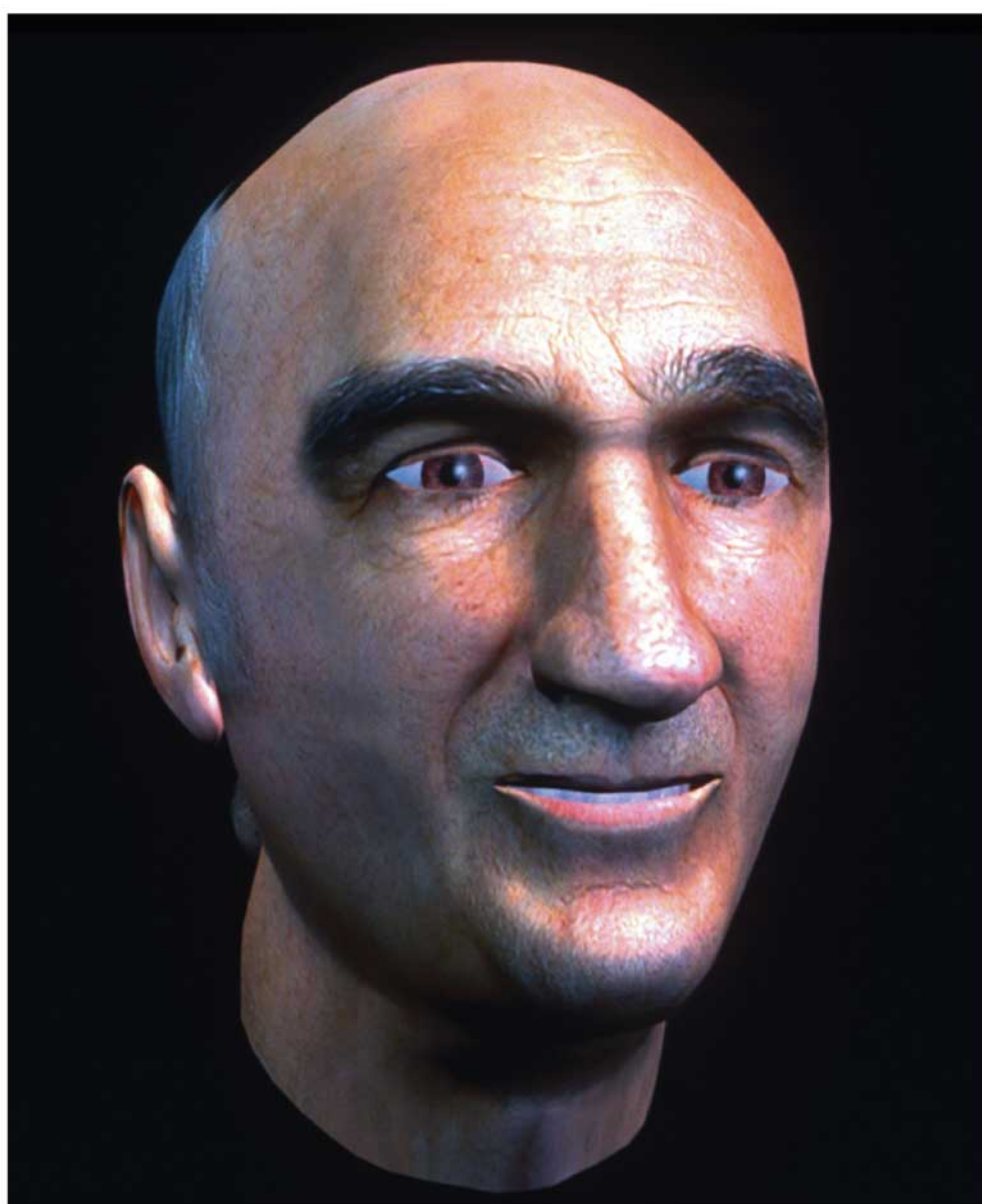


### WELCOME

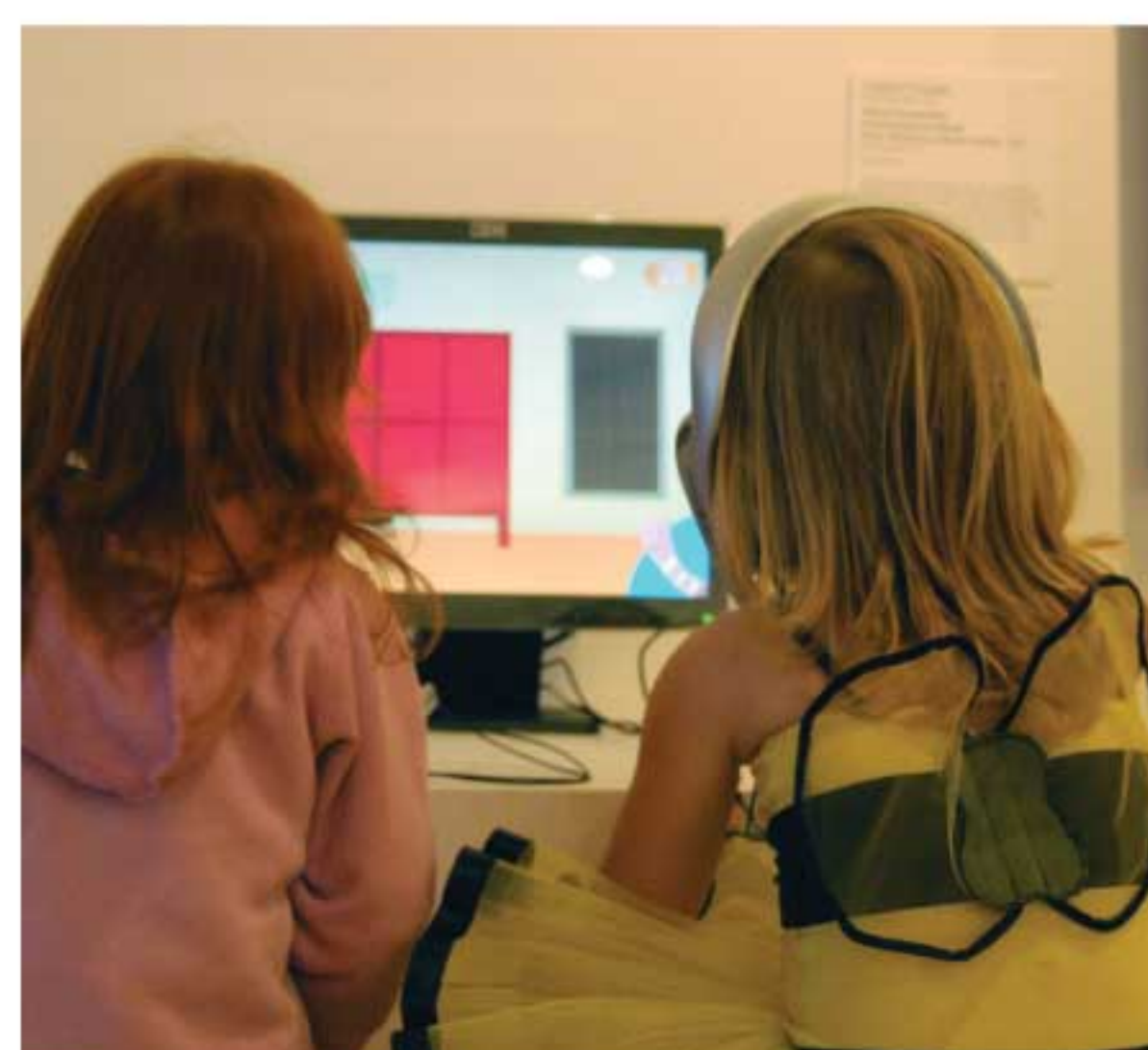
### KIDS CORNER ACTIVITIES
