Albert Namatjira's adoption of the European medium of watercolour for his landscape paintings remain an inspiration to contemporary artists from Ntaria (Hermannsburg) and surrounding regions of Central Australia. Since the 1930's, artists have been producing vibrant and highly regarded art that has made their country celebrated throughout Australia.

Previously on display at the Queensland Art Gallery, this exhibition highlights works by Indigenous Australian artists from the Hermannsburg School, and includes watercolours, ceramics and acrylic paintings on canvas.
