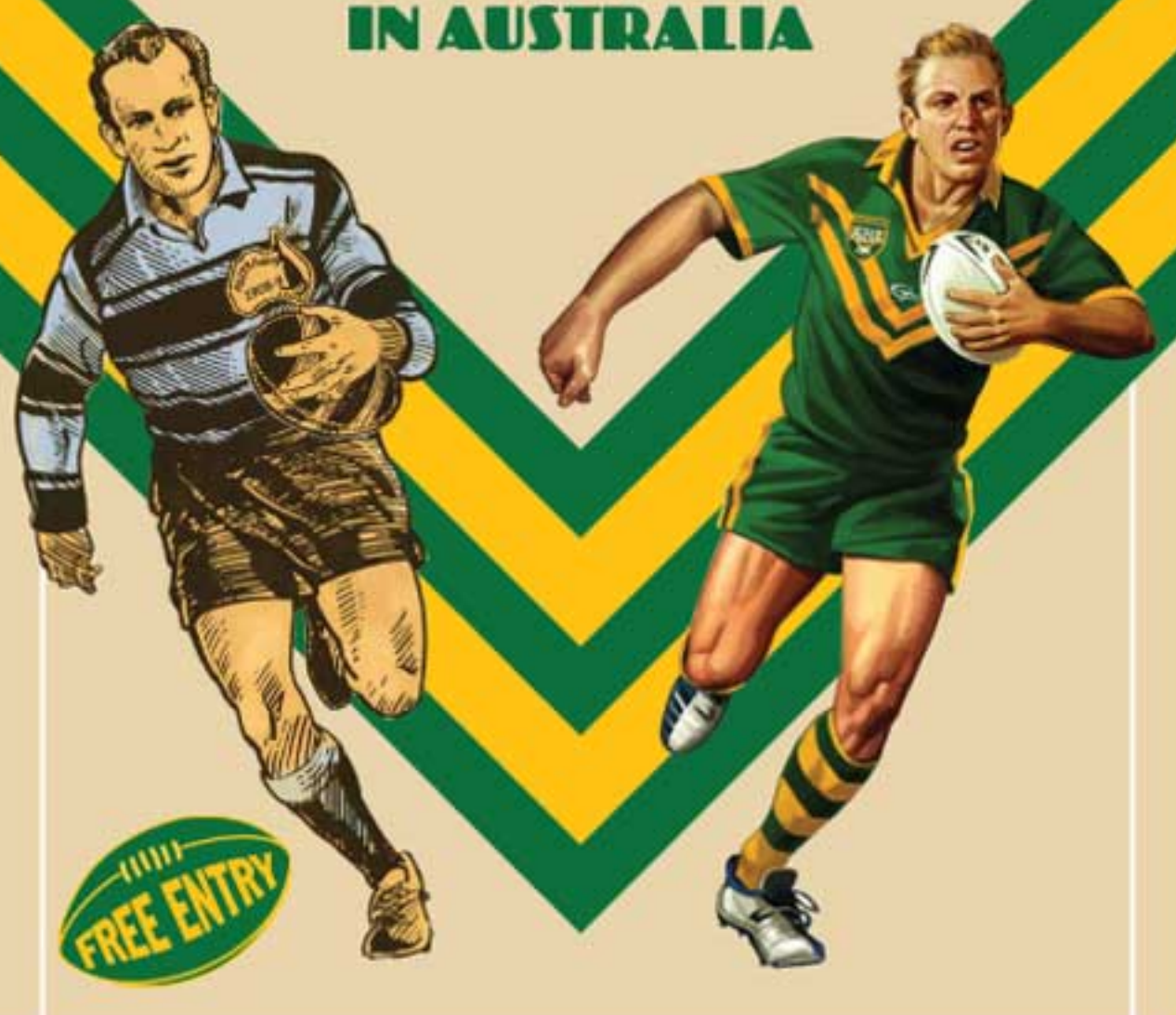

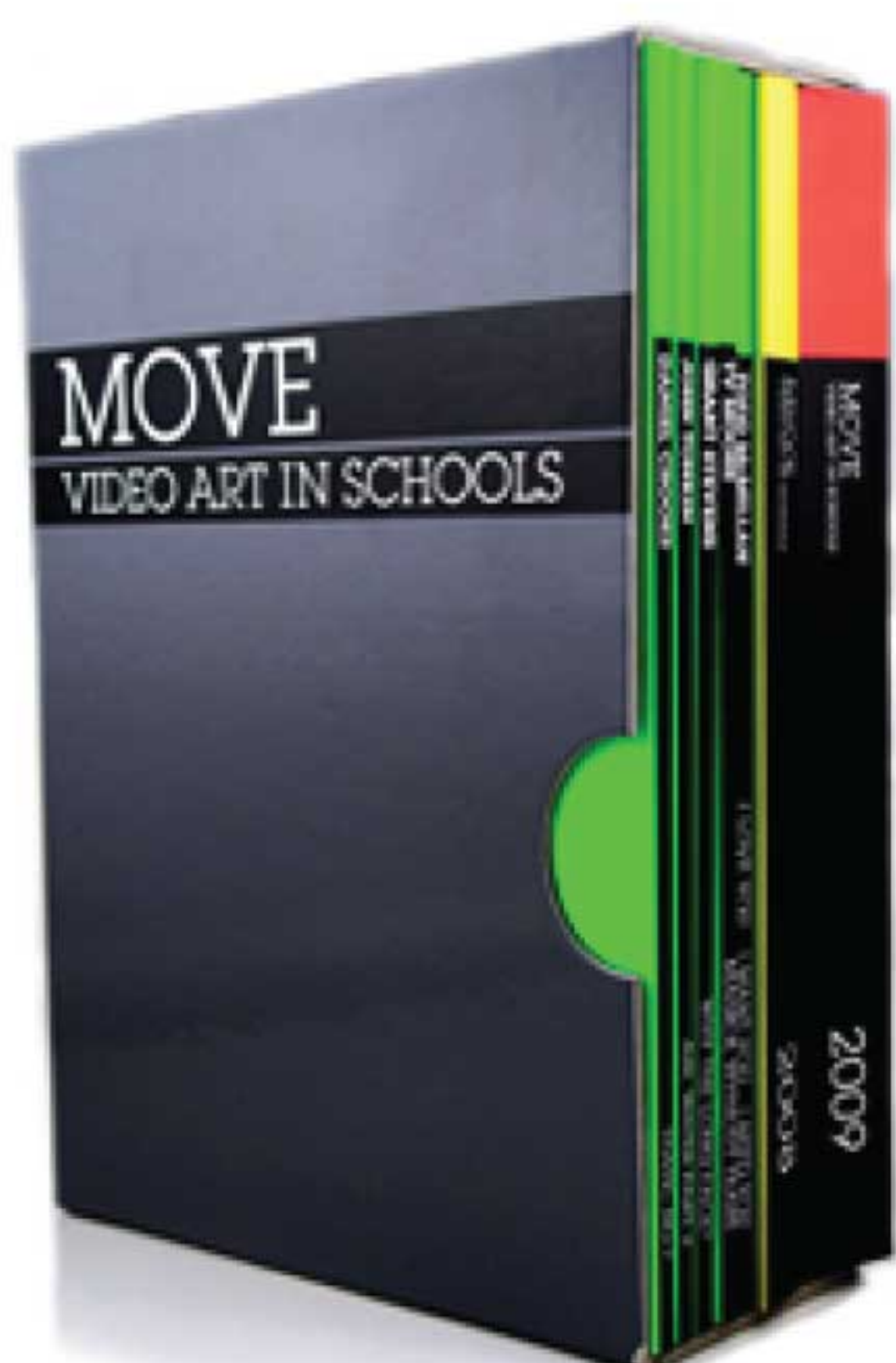
### *Deluge: Photographs from the Bundaberg Floods*
