### *Without a Brush* by The Baldwin Swamp Group

In this exhibition each artist has been forced out of their comfort zone to produce art without the use of a traditional brush. This concept has produced some very interesting and unusual pieces, using items such as kitchen utensils, sticks, string, credit cards and more.

### *Greed* by Christine Turner

This installation looks at the Global Financial Crisis which sent shockwaves around the world resulting in the collapse of large financial institutions and evictions and foreclosures in the housing market.

Wed 29 June 10am – 12noon for 9 – 11 year olds

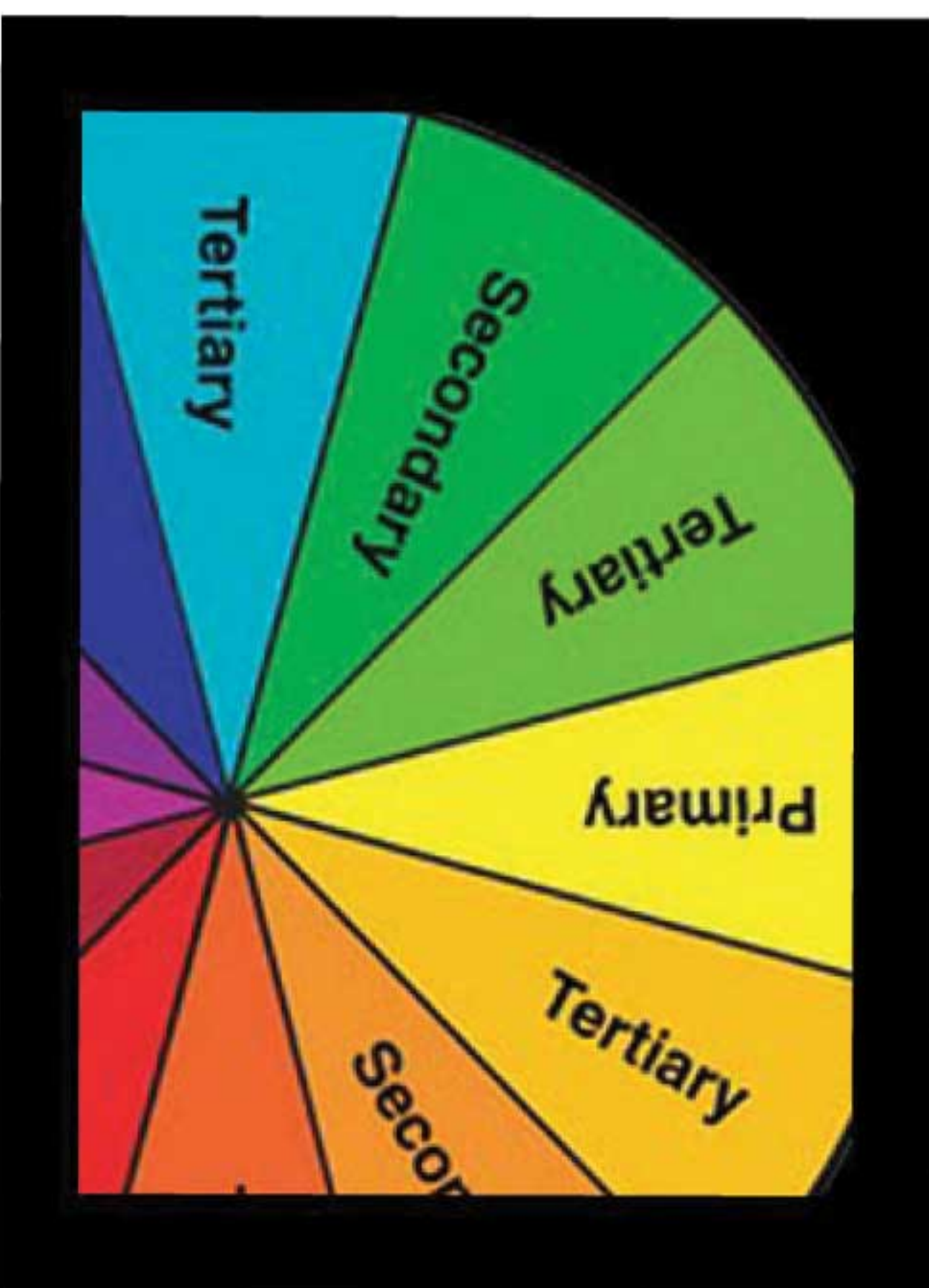
