PD WORKSHOPS FOR PRIMARY TEACHERS - FABRIC COLOURING

Fabric colouring is a great way to introduce students to creating wearable art, build on their knowledge of the colour wheel and look at the application of one product onto different textiles. Work with a non toxic and environmentally friendly product and learn how to fabric colour a t-shirt as well as watching other demonstrations. Each participant will fabric colour a calico bag and do a salt sample both of which can be taken away. This workshop also includes take home notes as a useful reminder.
