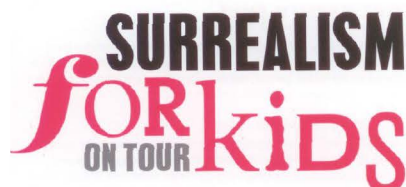
BRAG: Mon 26 Sept to Sun 2 Oct

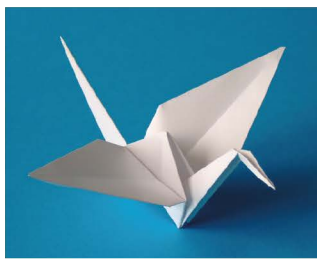

ORIGAMI IN THE SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

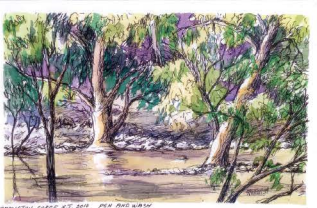
